

- 1. Please lift up in prayer Rev. Adrian Smith and Rev. Cicely Athill-Horsford as they travel this weekend to attend the Unity Mission Conference which will be held from November 15 to 20 in Cape Town, South Africa. Some 200 representatives from the world-wide Moravian Church will be gathering for mutual inspiration and reflection on the way forward in pursuit of the mission of the Church.
- **2.** The Ministers of Music serving within the Province will be meeting in Barbados from November 26 December 1, 2017. The primary purpose of this meeting will be to continue the work on the music edition of the **Caribbean Moravian Praise Hymnal**.
 - ↑ As part of these meetings, choir members, musicians and other interested members are invited to meet at Sharon Moravian Church from 7:00 − 9:00 p.m. beginning on Monday, November 27 to Wednesday November 29, 2017. During these sessions, participants will be invited to sing

through portions of the hymnal. Since this activity is part of the ongoing editorial process for the music edition, participants will be asked to pay attention to the melodic and harmonic accuracy of the music that has been scored.

- Those who will participate are asked to contact the Conference Office to have emailed to them, a digital copy of the booklet containing the hymns that will be reviewed. Limited copies of the booklet containing the selected hymns will be available.
- † Let's play our part in assisting the production of the musical edition of the Caribbean Moravian Praise Hymnal.
- **3.** The Fulnec congregation will host a **Thanksgiving Service in tribute of the late Bro. Lisle Brathwaite and Bro. William Jones**, both of whom served faithfully at Fulnec and in the wider Barbados Conference. The service will be held on Sunday, December 10, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. Members of the Conference are invited to attend.
- 4. The PEC in consultation with the Superintendents across the Province has decided to postpone the 32nd Provincial Synod of the Moravian Church Eastern West Indies Province for one (1) year, until July 5 to 11, 2019. This is to allow those Conferences in the North which were affected by Hurricanes Irma and Maria to recover. The full announcement from the PEC can be found on the Notice Board. The Barbados Conference therefore has a bit more time to prepare for the Synod and we ask members and friends of the Moravian Church to continue with their weekly contributions of at least \$1.00 towards those costs for which the Conference will be responsible. This contribution will be collected on the First Sunday of each month. Envelopes are available.
- 5. We express thanks to those who prepared for, contributed and supported our **Annual Fish Fry** in April. Receipts totaled \$17,581.45 and our Expenses \$4,797.18, giving a surplus of \$12,784.27. Thanks for your continual support.
- **6.** The **Liturgy Book**, the companion to our Caribbean Moravian Praise hymnal is now available to those who already own a hymnal. You can collect a copy from the Church Office. For those who have ordered a copy of the hymnal, please note that the second printing of the hymnal has been delayed while typographical errors in the first printing are corrected.
- 7. Our **Missionary Festival at Sharon** was held on Tuesday, October 17, 2017. We gathered \$13,635 towards our target of \$20,000. Contributions can still be made until year end.
- **8.** Groups and Organizations are requested to prepare their **Calendar of Events for 2018** and submit such to the Pastoral team by Sunday, November 26, 2017.
- **9. Flowers are needed for our church!** You will find on the wall next to the main door to the church, a roster in the shape of flower. You may sign up to indicate that you would (1) cover the cost to obtain flowers for the arrangements or (2) provide the complete arrangements, for a
