### **Scripture:**

**Psalm 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God! I will be praised among the nations, I will be praised in the earth. (MKJV)**

### **Message:**

**For many persons to be quiet or to be still is a challenge. They must always be on the move, going at a swift pace. There must always be lots of noise in the background whether it is from the radio, television or a portable device such as a cell phone. There must be lots of activity or movement. Even downtime or relaxation periods are filled with noise and clamour. They are not comfortable with silence or moments of peace. But how else are we to hear what is happening around us unless we are silent? How else are we to hear what God has to say to us unless we are quiet?**

**Many times we take our concerns to the Lord and then say He does not answer our prayers. But if we surround ourselves with the noise and activities, as well as the things and people that are not of God, we are deafening ourselves to the leading of God. When we place our lives in the hands of God, we have to give over to Him and it means listening to what He has to say to us. Be still, be quiet and listen to Almighty God so that you can hear what He wants you to do and where He wants you to go.**
