Scripture:

Psalm 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God! I will be praised among the nations, I will be praised in the earth. (MKJV)

Message:

If you try to talk and listen to somebody else talking at the same time, you would not hear what the other person is saying. To hear what the person is saying, you have to be quiet and listen. There are persons who must have a lot of noise around them at all times. The radio or television must be on some station from morning to night. On the sports field, they must be the one making the most noise. When there is so much noise everywhere, we then miss hearing what can be the more important things in life.

We need to remember that it is by being silent or being quiet is the time when we can hear a lot of what is happening around us. The verse says to be still and know that He is God. Be still so you can hear what God is saying to you, when He is leading you in the right direction. When you ask God a question or take your problems to Him, you need to be quiet so as to hear the answer He gives to you or the solution to your problems. It is important to be still, to be quiet so as to hear from God, and know that He is God.
