December 20 – Cleansing

Scripture:

Isaiah 1:18,19 Come now, let us reason together, says the Lord: though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall become like wool. If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land. (RSV)

Message:

To clean a house is to make it spotless and free of as much dust as possible. So there are times during the year such as Christmas and Easter when your parents would tumble the whole house to make it clean. They also do the daily and weekly cleaning to make sure that all live in a clean environment. It is the same with our lives. We need to do daily cleaning to make sure that sin does not take control.
