Scripture: (Read with me)

Luke 17: 5 - 10

5 The apostles said to the Lord, "Give us more faith!"

6 He replied, "Suppose you have faith as small as a mustard seed. Then you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be pulled up. Be planted in the sea.' And it will obey you.



7 "Suppose one of you has a servant plowing or looking after the sheep. And suppose the servant came in from the field. Will you say to him, 'Come along now and sit down to eat'? 8 No. Instead, you will say, 'Prepare my supper. Get yourself ready. Wait on me while I eat and drink. Then after that you can eat and drink.' 9 Will you thank the servant because he did what he was told to do? 10 It's the same with you. Suppose you have done everything you were told to do. Then you should say, 'We are not worthy to serve you. We have only done our duty.'"

Message:

Let's talk about it.

Now, we might first ask ourselves, "What is faith?"

Faith may be described as complete trust or confidence in someone or something.

A further description of faith is a strong belief in God or in the doctrines of a religion, based on spiritual apprehension rather than proof. We have no proof, but yet we believe that it is real.

In Hebrews 11:1 we read "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen".

Faith is the connecting power into the spiritual realm, which links us with God and makes Him become a tangible reality to the sense or perceptions of a person. By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.

We show faith in God by praying to God and asking for forgiveness. As we believe that Jesus is the son of God, and recognize that like everyone else, we have sinned, then we can pray to God asking for forgiveness.

Remember the story that we did a few weeks ago about the friends that made a hole in the roof so that Jesus can heal their friend? Remember that Jesus told the man, get up and take up your bed and walk. The friends had faith that Jesus could heal their friend.

Remember the woman who was sick for a long time. She said that if she could just touch the hem of Jesus' garment she would be healed. What did Jesus tell her? Daughter, your faith has made you whole. She was healed by faith. Each time Jesus healed someone, He told them that it was their faith that worked for them. These people really believed that Jesus would heal them. They had no proof, but they believed.

Do you have faith in anyone? Maybe you believe in your parents, or in your friend. You believe that they love you and will do nothing to harm you.

Here are some ways that you can build your faith in God:

- Place your faith actively in God.
- > Love God and love others without judgment.
- Obey God in His timing.
- ➢ Worship God with a thankful heart.

Let us pray.

Father God, the peace that comes through faith in You surpasses all human understanding. Help me to keep my faith in You alone that I would have peace. The world wants to destroy the peace I have through faith in You. Protect my mind and heart from the things of this world. Pour out your perfect peace. Activity: The healing of Jairus's daughter was another demonstration of faith in Jesus' power. Read the story in Mark 5: 35 - 43.
