July 26 – Be Self-Controlled

Scripture:

Galatians 5:22,23 But the fruit the Holy Spirit produces is love, joy and peace. It is being patient, kind and good. It is being faithful 23 and gentle and having control of oneself. There is no law against things of that kind. (NIRV)

Message:

To be self-controlled is to have control over yourself in all areas of your life. It is to control your thoughts, your actions, what you say, what you do, how you behave. It is also control over the friends you have, the places you go, the things you see or watch on your tablets, the clothes you wear, even the foods that you eat. You have to be responsible to a large measure of what happens in your life so that the beauty of Jesus is always seen in you.

Notice that to be self-controlled is where YOU take control of your life in the name of the Lord. It is where you try your best to be what God wants you to be. This can be done when you let God control your life, control all that you think, speak and do. With God in control of your life, you can be sure that you will say the right things, go the right places and do what is right in His sight.
