July 5 – Safety

Scripture:

Psalm 23: 1 The Lord is my shepherd. He gives me everything I need. 2 He lets me lie down in fields of green grass. He leads me beside quiet waters. 3 He gives me new strength. He guides me in the right paths for the honour of his name. 4 Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will not be afraid. You are with me. Your shepherd's rod and staff comfort me. 5 You prepare a feast for me right in front of my enemies. You pour oil on my head. My cup runs over. 6 I am sure that your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life. And I will live in the house of the Lord forever. (NIRV).

Message:

What a wonderful feeling it is when one feels safe and protected. When our parents and guardians look out for us and protect us, the world does not seem so dangerous after all. Psalm 23 tells of the Shepherd that looks after the flock and keeps them safe. It tells of how the Shepherd not only protects the sheep, but provides for them so that they would want for nothing while they are under His care.

The corona virus has spread all over the world and we are told of the many things we must do in order to protect ourselves and to be safe. We are told to wear masks, to sanitize, to wash our hands often as well as to keep our hands away from our faces. We too can be safe when we give our lives over to the great Shepherd so that He can take care of us. There is no need to fear when we are protected by the Lord as He will always protect us from harm and danger and keep us safe.

- ✓ **Do not shake hands with abomination. (Deuteronomy 25:16)**
- ✓ **Do not hug heresy and false teachings.(2 Peter 2:1)**
- ✓ **Be safe so that you will be saved. (Jeremiah 17:14)**
- ✓ **Sanitize your life with the Word of God. (Psalm 1:2).**
- ✓ **In case you notice any symptoms of sin, call the helpline of Christ in PRAYER.(Jeremiah 33:3)**
- ✓ **Always remember to boost your spiritual immunity with Faith and the Power of the Holy Spirit. (Jude 1:20).**
