Scripture:

Luke 8:16 No one lights a lamp and then covers it with a bowl or hides it under a bed. Instead, he puts the lamp on a lampstand so that those who come in will have enough light to see. (ICB)

Message:

A light is the difference between darkness and being able to see. So if you have a light which will help others to see, then you should not cover it over or hide it away. Light takes away darkness so that we can see the way ahead clearly. There are so many examples of darkness all around us. There is the darkness of sin and when we continue to sin over and over again, you can imagine how dark your life would be. To live in the light, we must come out of the darkness and leave behind the life of sin.

There is no sin Jesus cannot forgive in order for us to have a fresh start in life. Sin is darkness and no one likes to live in darkness. Jesus is the light of the world and it is through Him we can have forgiveness of sin. All we need to do is to confess to Jesus all we have done wrong and He will make us clean.
