Scripture:

Mark 1:16-20 And as He walked by the Sea of Galilee, He saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen.

17 Then Jesus said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men." **18** They immediately left their nets and followed Him. **19** When He had gone a little farther from there, He saw James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, who also were in the boat mending their nets.

20 And immediately He called them, and they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired servants, and went after Him. (NKJV)

Message:

Jesus chose different persons with different abilities to be His Disciples. They were going about their own business, doing their own thing when they were drafted into doing something even better, and that was to be a disciple for Jesus.
