FOCUS

November 1 – Be True

Scripture:

Ephesians 6:4 Fathers, do not make your children angry. Instead, instruct them and teach them the ways of the Lord as you raise them. (NIRV)

Message:

To be true is to be honest about what you say and what you do. To be true is to give of your best at all times, not saying that you are going to do something and then change your mind half way through the task or project. Just imagine a friend saying that they would help you with an assignment or project and in the middle of it, they changed their mind and you still don't understand what to do no matter how you try to do it on your own. That would be very disappointing.

The verse of scripture for today says to fathers to be true fathers to their children, not to anger them but to bring them up in the right way. True fathers look out for their children, taking care of their needs. They see to it that they have a place the children can call home, enough food, that they go to school and church to be educated and grow in the Lord. We pray that fathers would be true to their children, just as our Father in heaven is true to us.
