Scripture:

Exodus 20:16 Do not be a false witness against your neighbour. (NIRV)

Message:

Lying is an abomination unto the Lord. Proverbs 6: 16 and following tells us that among the things God hates are those who tell lies. To tell a lie is to say something that is not true. It is to say something that may get others and even yourself in trouble because the information is false. Just imagine if someone says something about you that is not true, or post something on social media that is totally untrue. That would surely hurt your feelings. You too must not tell lies, say untrue things about persons, or give out false or faulty information.
