November 8 – Do not steal

Scripture:

Exodus 20:15 Do not steal. (NIRV)

Message:

What is yours is yours and what is not yours does not belong to you. If you gain something without permission or without paying for it then that is stealing. You cannot see something that does not belong to you, pick it up and claim it as your own. It must belong to someone else, so by picking it up, you are stealing it. To steal is wrong and once you start stealing small things, you may move on to steal bigger things which may later on make you go to jail.

The Bible tells us that we must not steal. Imagine if you had something that is precious/special to you and you rest it down, turning away for just a minute to do something else. However when you returned, it was gone. That would make you very sad indeed, maybe even angry. Therefore if you do not want it to be done to you, then do not do it to others. Just as you love what belongs to you and want to keep it, remember that others feel the same way about the things they own and wish to keep it for a long time too.
