Scripture:

2 Samuel 17:37 And David said, "The Lord who delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear, will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine." And Saul said to David, "Go, and the Lord be with you!" (RSV)

Message:

In today's world, it is important to be strong, to be brave, to be certain, to be courageous in doing what is right. There are many things, events, situations and people that can upset you, discourage you and distract you from achieving your goals, even distract you from serving God. It calls for you to be strong.
