Scripture:

Matthew 4:4 "It is written, 'Man must not live only on bread. He must also live on every word that comes from the mouth of God." (NIRV)

Message:

Someone comes to you with a piece of news or information and you act based on what you have heard, not doing your own investigations to get the full picture. There may be times when this could work, but it is better when you see the whole picture especially before making a judgement or giving an opinion. We sometimes go in the wrong direction when we only hear half of the story, or act upon what we have heard and not on what we know for sure.

It is the same with our knowledge and relationship with Jesus Christ. It cannot be a half-way knowledge or a half-way relationship. We must know and understand fully what God desires of us. We are not to use the word of God conveniently to support what we want to do or accomplish. Or, if we want to justify a position or action, we look for a verse of scripture to say what we want to do. If something is right, it is right. However, if it is wrong, we should not try to find ways to make it right. Half the word of God is not good enough, we must try to live by all the directions given for a full life in Christ.
