Message:

**Let's talk about it.**

This story focuses on loyalty and friendship. God gives us friends so we can support and love each other. Sometimes those friendships change, but God's commitment to us never changes. We need to love and support our friends without expecting something in return. Naomi was indeed not only a mother-in-law but a friend, so much so that Ruth was willing to give up her false god and her family to accept Naomi's God and her people. Ruth pledged to follow Naomi. Even though Naomi was having a rough time and felt that she was being punished by God, after the death of her husband and her sons, Ruth still wanted to adopt the faith and join Naomi on her journey. What does this tell us about Naomi? Well, she must have been a pretty awesome mother-in-law! In order for Ruth to want to accept God as her God, Naomi must have done a great job of showing God's love to Ruth. She led Ruth to the Lord, whether or not she intended to do so. They returned to Bethlehem together. It was a good thing Ruth went with Naomi because Bethlehem was very far away and Naomi couldn't have traveled all that way by herself. Ruth was good company for Naomi. Ruth never complained but was a good friend to Naomi. She wasn't expecting anything in return, she just wanted to help.

Being a good friend takes a long time to learn. A good friend is loyal, which means you keep your promises. Sometimes our friends aren't perfect and they make mistakes and sometimes say or do things that hurt us. But we make mistakes too, and we don't want our friends to leave us when that happens. There will be times when you don't feel like being a friend but you are a friend anyway.

As for Ruth, she returns the favour of showing God's love to Naomi by supporting her in the good times and the bad. When they got to Bethlehem, Ruth decided that she should do some kind of work. She recognized that it was her turn to help Naomi. It was harvest time, so she worked in the fields following behind the harvesters and picked up any barley that they had dropped.

Ruth's capacity to love, which is a God-given ability, triumphed over Naomi's inconsolable pain and grief and brings her joy once again!

God gives us friends when we need them, and we should treat them like a gift from God.



Ruth had such a good attitude and wanted to help, she moved away from everyone she knew and went to be with Naomi. She knew that she should be a friend like God wanted her to be.
