First Scripture Reading: Isaiah 55: 10 – 13 – Bro. Edwin Sandiford

- **10.** For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:
- 11. So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

Second Scripture Reading: Romans 8: 1 – 11 – Sis. Eula Gibbs

- 1. There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- 2. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.
- **3.** For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:
- **4.** That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- 5. For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.
- 6. For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.
- 7. Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.
- 8. So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.
- 9. But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.
- **10.** And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.
- **11.** But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.
