

Ministry of the Word

First Scripture Reading: 1 Thessalonians 5:1 – 11

- 1. But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have no need that I write unto you.
- **2.** For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.
- **3.** For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.
- **4.** But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief.
- 5. Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.
- **6.** Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober.
- 7. For they that sleep sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night.

- **8.** But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.
- **9.** For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,
- **10.** Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him.
- **11.** Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.



Second Scripture Reading:

Matthew 25:14 - 30

- **14.** For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods.
- **15.** And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.
- **16.** Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents.
- 17. And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two.
- **18.** But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.
- 19. After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.
- **20.** And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more.
- **21.** His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

- **23.** His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

- **24.** Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed:
- **25.** And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.
- **26.** His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:
- **27.** Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury.
- **28.** Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents.
- **29.** For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.
- **30.** And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.


