## First Scripture Reading: James 3: 13 – 18

- **13.** Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom.
- **14.** But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.
